5. BUSINESS:

A. Capital Improvement Project Update. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Clerk
Pervenanze stated that the project has started on Grant Location Rd and will move
up Pennsylvania to State St. Residents will be notified by Casper Construction if
access and services are restricted. Additionally, Engineer Jamnick completed the
drawing for the proposed residential development on the ball fields. Motion by

- Klarich to approve the development drawing and move forward with platting the land. Supported by Lehman. Motion carried unanimously.
- B. New Fire Hall Door. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Clerk Pervenanze stated that the Fire Department is requesting a new door on the fire hall. Motion by Markas to approve the quote from Overhead Door in the amount of \$1,850. Supported by Milich. Motion carried unanimously.
- C. Salvation Army Heat Share Agreement. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Clerk Pervenanze stated that this agreement allows the City to work with the Salvation Army for those who apply for energy assistance. Motion by Lehman to approve the agreement with the Salvation Army. Supported by Milich. Motion carried unanimously.
- D. Coalition of Greater MN Cities Dues. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Mayor Klarich stated that the City has not joined this organization in the past and other organizations serve a similar purpose. Motion by Klarich to decline the membership and dues proposal from the Coalition of Greater MN Cities. Supported by Markas. Motion carried unanimously.
- E. Dumpster Rental Agreement. Discussion. Approve/Reject. Clerk Pervenanze stated that earlier the Council agreed to partner with the City of Chisholm to offer dumpster rentals to residents. The agreement calls for a rental charge of \$60 for Buhl residents and the proceeds split 60/40 between Chisholm and Buhl. Motion by Lehman to approve the dumpster rental agreement with the City of Chisholm. Supported by Milich. Motion carried unanimously.
